Palazzo Massarucci is a large, magnificent palace that sits atop a mountain in the hills between Acquasparta, Terni and Spoleto in southern Umbria, Italy, only 1½ hours north of Rome. Within its 1,000 square meters (10,000 sq. ft.), you'll find 9 bedrooms, 6 bathrooms, 3 full kitchens, an indoor wood-burning oven, an indoor grill, skylights, terraces, lofts, under-floor heating as well as 6 working fireplaces. The palazzo dates back to 1500 when the original owners, the Massarucci family, built it on the foundations of a medieval fortress. It stands as the outer wall of the tiny village of Macerino and it enjoys the glorious views of the hills and valleys below which have remained unchanged over the centuries. Vast forests surround the palace, rich with truffles, wild asparagus and wild mushrooms. Lovingly restored with an eye to comfort, the Palazzo has been turned into 4 separate apartments, each with its own separate heating system. Some of them have frescoes and a lot of very beautiful features. A beautiful panoramic terrace and a large swimming pool, a sauna and three double tubs proffering a spa-like experience complete the property.
